MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)
OF ACADEMIC COLLABORATION

BETWEEN

Vishwakarma Institute of Technology, Pune (VIT)

and

International University of Chabahar, Iran (IUC)

Whereas Mr.Akbar Badpa, Faculty & International Relations Officer, International University of Chabahar, Iran approached Prin. V.K.Wagh (Ex. Principal, Fergusson College, Pune), Director, Oscan with a request for help in getting good faculty from Pune in the field of Computer Science for International University of Chabahar, Iran on short term academic assignments in IUC and whereas Prin. V.K.Wagh agreed upon to extend the help using his contacts in the academic field.

Whereas Prin. V.K. Wagh suggested Mr.Badpa, it will be good IUC to establish academic collaboration between reputed academic institutes in Pune in the field of Computer Science, so that IUC, Iran will be academically gratefully benefited and Mr.Badpa agreed upon the suggestions after discussing with DR. H.R. Mirzaei Chancellor of IUC, Iran.

Whereas Prin. V.K. Wagh talked to the Management and the Dr. H.K. Abhyankar principal of Vishwakarma Institute of Technology (VIT) , Pune about the proposal of academic collaboration between VIT and IUC and the Management of VIT responded favorably, it was decided to have bilateral Memorandum of Understanding. It was unanimously agreed that

1. The Management of VIT will depute competent faculty in the field of Computer Science to IUC on semester to semester basis as per the requirement of IUC. Generally, the requirement would be 2 to 3 faculty members each semester.
2. All the expenses of the deputed faculty members including their present salary (total emoluments), well furnished accommodation, maintenance allowance, deputation allowance, other perks including conveyance allowance etc will be borne by IUC. All expenses of international travel from Pune to Iran & back and internal domestic travel within Iran will also be borne by IUC. IUC will also take care of all matters such as visa, work permit, residence permit in respect of the deputed faculty members and other invitees. IUC will make arrangements for the visit of deputed faculty and invitees to the places of interest and tourist attraction in Iran.
3. IUC may send their own faculty for exposure and training in the field of Computer Science to VIT. All expenses in this regard will be borne by the IUC. VIT will extend hospitality and help for the comfortable stay for the faculty of IUC during their period of stay in Pune.
4. Both VIT & IUC may consider the possibility of student exchange on either side to promote cultural and academic exchange between the two countries. All expenses in this regard will be borne by the students or their respective institutes.
5. The MOU will be in force initially for a period of three years beginning from the date of signing this MOU and may be extended further if both the parties agree upon.

6. The MOU may be extended to other subject areas later on the same terms and conditions.
7. The MOU may be terminated by either side with advance notice of six months if either of the parties wishes to do so, it being understood that ongoing programme of academic collaborations will be conducted smoothly till the end of that semester.
8. This MOU was signed by the representatives of VIT and IUC on 30th August 2007 and comes into force with immediate effect.

Both VIT and IUC are grateful to Prin. V.K.Wagh and Oscan for the help in materializing this MOU and assure our help and support in promoting the activities of Oscan for the benefit of students aspiring for higher education abroad and developing English language proficiency and personality.




